

Birthday SMS

The Birthday SMS function in evo22.my allows you to import and personalized a list of mobile numbers & birthday greetings, along with the preferred date/time to send the SMS.

The following are procedures to prepare and import the Birthday SMS list.

Preparing of Birtherday SMS File:

The file **MUST** be prepared as ".csv" file type, and the filename must **NOT** have symbols such as ', ", #, <, >, & etc.

The content format is as follow:

<Date>,<Time>,<Mobile Number>,<Msg Type>,<Msg Variable>,<Msg Template>

whereby:

- <Date> - Schedule Date , DD/MM/yyyy;
- <Time> - Schedule Time, HH:MM;
- <Mobile Number> - Mobile Number;
- <Msg Type> - "N" for normal text SMS, and "U" for Unicode SMS;
- <Msg Variable> - Replace text string, such as the recipient's name;
- <Msg Template> - SMS message template, place <REPLACE> for replacement of msg variable string.

Example:

```
08/08/2010,09:00,60121234567,N,Amy Tan,Hi <REPLACE>, Happy Birthday!!
08/08/2010,09:00,60121234567,N,Amy Tan,Hi <REPLACE>, Happy Birthday!!
09/08/2010,09:15,60122345678,N,Andrea Sik,Hi <REPLACE>, Happy Birthday!!
10/08/2010,09:30,60123456789,N,Daniel Leong,Hi <REPLACE>, Happy Birthday!!
11/08/2010,09:45,60124567890,N,Alan Chan,Hi <REPLACE>, Happy Birthday!!
```

The SMS Message Output would then be:

```
Hi Amy Tan, Happy Birthday!!
Hi Andrea Sik, Happy Birthday!!
Hi Daniel Leong, Happy Birthday!!
Hi Alan Chan, Happy Birthday!!
```

Note:

Please keep to a maximum of **300 entries** per file.

Once the Birthday SMS file is processed, all Birthday SMS will be scheduled and stored into the schedule list buffer. You may view/delete the scheduled birthday SMS at any time before the scheduled date/time is reached.
